

Here are the steps to install the Epson Stylus Photo R260 on a Mac using the Legacy_StylusPhoto2_1262_AM.dmg file:

1. Download the driver:

If you haven't already, download the Legacy_StylusPhoto2_1262_AM.dmg file from the Epson support website or a trusted source. Here's the download link:
https://ftp.epson.com/drivers/Legacy_StylusPhoto2_1262_AM.dmg

2. Locate the downloaded file:

Go to your "Downloads" folder, or the location where you saved the downloaded file, and find the Legacy_StylusPhoto2_1262_AM.dmg file.

3. Open the .dmg file:

Double-click on the Legacy_StylusPhoto2_1262_AM.dmg file to mount the installer.

4. Run the installer:

Once the .dmg file is mounted, you should see a new window with the installer package. Double-click on the .pkg file (it should have a box icon with an arrow) to start the installation process.

5. Follow the installation prompts:

The installer will guide you through the installation process. Follow the on-screen instructions, read and accept the license agreement, and click "Install" to begin the installation.

6. Enter your password:

You may be prompted to enter your Mac's administrator password to authorize the installation. Enter the password and click "Install Software."

7. Complete the installation:

Wait for the installation to finish. Once it's done, you will see a confirmation message. Click "Close" to exit the installer.

8. Connect the printer:

If you haven't already, connect your Epson Stylus Photo R260 printer to your Mac using the appropriate cable (usually a USB cable). Also, make sure the printer is powered on.

9. Add the printer in System Preferences:

- a. Click on the Apple menu in the top-left corner of your screen and select "System Preferences."
- b. Click on "Printers & Scanners."
- c. If the printer is not automatically detected, click on the "+" (plus) icon at the bottom-left of the "Printers & Scanners" window to add a new printer.
- d. Select your Epson Stylus Photo R260 printer from the list and click "Add."

Now, your Epson Stylus Photo R260 printer should be installed and ready to use on your Mac.
